



## 48-inch Potomac PCCP Repairs

Crews working for WSSC will be in your neighborhood soon to replace three sections of the 48-inch Potomac PCCP as part of our infrastructure renewal program. **Construction is expected to begin on or about Monday, June 11, 2018 and be complete by Mid-August weather permitting.** Final restoration of sidewalks roadways and landscaping will take place within 90 days of construction completion.

Please see the project map on the back to view the streets where work will be taking place.

### **WHAT TO EXPECT**

- New water mains will be installed using an open-cut construction method, which involves cutting and excavating a section of the pavement. This construction method does create noise and dust. This type of work is typically done during the day unless otherwise required as a condition of the work permit.
- Excavation areas will be steel plated and the road will be opened during non-working hours.
- Anticipated Work Hours: **Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.** Work may occasionally extend beyond these hours to complete specific tasks.
- Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead as single-lane closures may cause delays during working hours on Tilden Lane. Safety cones and signs will be in place to keep the work zone safe.

### **IMPACTS**

- **WSSC does not anticipate residents will experience a loss of water service in relations to this project.**
- Parking restrictions will be in effect on Tilden Lane. WSSC will provide 48-hour advance notice prior to any parking restrictions. Please note, during any parking restrictions, residents will maintain have access to your homes. Any vehicles that have not been removed from the area (as denoted by "No Parking" signs) by the time the parking restrictions take effect will be towed to a nearby street at no cost to the owner.
